ESL for Academics - ESL-ACAD

ESL-ACAD is a 5-month program that is of academic nature and is purely meant for students. The program is divided into 5 major components. Successful completion of these components makes a student eligible to take Academic/Applied Grade-10 English Course at a Canadian high school.

The ESL A, B, C, D, and E courses are offered in the ESL-ACAD program.

ESL-A: Beginning Communication in English	ESL-B: English in Daily Life	ESL-C: English for School and Work
Level-1- Prerequisite: None This is the beginner's course in English. This course builds on students' previous education and language knowledge to introduce them to the English language and help them adjust to the diversity in their new environment. Students will use the beginning English language skills in listening, speaking, reading and writing for everyday and essential academic purposes.	Level-2-Course-Prerequisite: Level 1 or Equivalent or through an initial assessment. This course extends students' listening, speaking, reading and writing skills in English for everyday and academic purposes. Students will practice conversation in structured situations designed for English language learners, and expand their knowledge of English grammatical structures and sentence patterns.	Level-3-Course-Prerequisite: Level 2 or Equivalent or through an initial assessment. This course further extends students' skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Students learn to give short presentations in the classroom. Also, students read a variety of adapted and original texts, as well as write using a variety of text forms. Students will also expand their academic vocabulary, and their study skills to facilitate their transition into the mainstream school
		program.

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ESL-D: Study Skills in English	ESL-E: Bridge to English
Level-4-Course-Prerequisite: Level 3 or Equivalent or through an initial assessment.	Level-5-Course-Prerequisite: Level 4 or Equivalent or through an initial assessment.
This course prepares students to use English with increasing fluency and accuracy in classroom and social situations, and to participate in Canadian society as informed citizens. Students will further improve their oral-presentation, reading, and writing skills required for success in all school subjects.	This course provides students with the skills and strategies they need to make the transition to college and university preparation English courses. Students will be encouraged to develop independence in a range of academic tasks. They will participate in debates, lead classroom workshops, read and interpret literary works and academic texts, and write essays, narratives and reports.

If a student secures more than 70% of marks in ESL-E, they are eligible to take English-10 Academic (ENG2D1). In case of less than 70% of marks, they can join English-10 Applied (ENG2P1).
